Student Code of Conduct: toward host family

- Help with household chores.
- Keep your room and bathroom tidy.
- Keep your belongings in your room.
- Inform your host family in advance of your arrival of any dietary restrictions or preferences.
- Observe the family rules. There is a USS lights out policy of midnight. Students are expected to get an adequate amount of sleep each night in order to be alert during class. This time will be enforced by your host family.
- Limit screen time during Host Family time and meal times. Use this time to interact with your host family and school-mate.
- The 10:30 p.m. school day curfew is to be observed unless prior permission is given to extend it.
- Always be ready on time.
- Direct any problems/concerns to a USS staff member or one of the Board of Directors.
- If using the host family computer or Wi-Fi, please be respectful. Do not dominate the use of the computer or Wi-Fi nor go to any websites that may be objectionable. If in doubt, ask.

Student Code of Conduct: whilst at school

School attire will be: USS polo shirt in team color (provided), USS badge (provided), black/cream/olive green/grey/navy or brown trousers, closed toed, comfortable shoes. Girls may wear a knee-length skirt in one of the colors listed.

- Be on time for all events.
- Personal electronic devices such as cell phones, smart phones, iPods, iPads, etc. must be turned off and put away during the school day and at other school functions.
- Pay attention to what you are told by mentors, guest speakers, and USS staff.
- Students must check-in & check-out each school day with a USS staff member as well as before and after each school function.
- Students should walk quietly in the hallways when traveling between classrooms, to and from the restroom and at other break periods. As guests of the UHCL facility we are expected to behave with the utmost respect. USS students failing to do so will be reprimanded.
